ARP-ESSER Grant Activities

Families United Network – Ashler Manor Residential Services was allocated \$64,008.00 through the ARP's Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief (ESSER) grant. Funds from this grant may be utilized for various allowable expenses, as outlined in the grant, dating back to March 13, 2020, through Sept. 30, 2024. The state's priorities of this grant: Return to In-Person Learning, Safely Reopening Schools and Sustaining Safe Operations, Addressing the Academic and Other Impacts of Lost Instructional Time, and Investing in Summer Learning and Expanded After-School Programs.

Additional ESSER funding available through ARP is intended to address the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic on our most vulnerable students. The funding should be used for mitigation strategies that include addressing the interrupted instruction, meeting students' social, emotional, mental health and academic needs, summer programming, and staff capacity.
