THEME: MY SUMMER SUPERPOWER

TO PARTICIPATE

Children and youth ages 0-21 are encouraged to create one piece of original artwork to represent 'My Summer Superpower.' Artwork should be no larger than 8.5 x 11 inches. Participants should have a current or past affiliation with Families United Network, through foster care, adoption, residential, peer services, or the child of staff or affiliated families.

TO SUBMIT

Each participant should submit their completed artwork and application/release form by August 31, 2025. Submissions can given to any FUN employee, mailed to, Families United Network, (276 Ashler Manor Drive, Muncy, PA 17756; Attention: Erica Weaver) or submitted via email eweaver@families4kids.org.

VOTING

Artwork will be separated into **4 groups based on age** (0-4, 5-9, 10-15, and 16-21) for voting. In **September**, members of Families United Network's Board of Directors will view and vote on the original artwork! Relevance to the theme, creativity, originality, and overall impression will be considered while voting.

RESULTS

Be on the look out for winners to be announced on FUN's website and social media by **October 1, 2025.** Prizes will be awarded to the winner of each age group. Winners artwork will be published into a 2026 calendar.
