Certified Peer Support (CPS) is a non-clinical service being offered to individuals in Luzerne and Wyoming Counties. CPS will assist individuals in building on their strengths to achieve desired outcomes. Our goal is to increase the participants' ability to function better in the home, school, and community by mentoring, connecting them to different resources, and assisting with problem-solving.

The CPS has experience with mental health diagnosis and can relate to the individuals they work with by helping them with the acceptance and understanding of their mental health diagnosis. CPS serves as a role model demonstrating how to have effective relationships, interactions, and behaviors. CPS will share their own experiences as needed to establish a bond based on similar experiences.

CPS helps individuals gain the knowledge, skills, and confidence to effectively manage their own needs and become more independent.
